

Show Regulations

1. The Show will open at 9:00am
2. Dogs will be housed at any time, but it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. Judging will commence at 9:30am. *private*
4. Exhibits may be received from the Show after they judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tanning and housing areas is forbidden except as authorized by the Show Management.
6. Entry fees: £4.50 per dog for first entry, subsequent entries £1.00 per dog per class.
7. There is no prize money on offer at this show.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries.
9. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. The entry of females within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.

1. A BEST PUPPY SHOW

When a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a Puppy which has completed and is exhibited by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A Puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a Puppy, it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been judged by an able dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, substitutes of Best Puppy in Breed and Puppy in Show must follow selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.

Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are exhibited by another puppy.

B. WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION

Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competitions, other than Best of Breed and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show in order to remain exhibitors. A Puppy taken in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competitions for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.

Puppies may be withdrawn from ANY Classes when judged before Best of Breed.

C. PHOENIX

For the purpose of this regulation, dogs become in competition for Best Dog, Best of Breed, Property, Breed and Team or a Special Award continued to run based with any dog which has been judged.

A. BEST IN SHOW

The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has completed and is exhibited by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from all exhibition winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining exhibition winning dogs following the selection of Best in Show.

B. WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION

Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competitions other than Best of Breed and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best in Show in order to remain exhibitors. A dog taken in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competitions for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from ANY Classes when judged before Best of Breed.

C. PHOENIX

For the purpose of this regulation, dogs become in competition for Best Dog, Best of Breed, Property, Breed and Team or a Special Award continued to run based with any dog which has been judged.

Exhibitors will not be allowed to field in Show competition after a period of six months has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and even only with the special permission of the Show Management.

For small numbers will be made to entry Schedule except for permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by an advertisement in the *Canine Press* whenever possible.

All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulations F (Items B). Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

All dogs resident outside the UK, must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete certificate before entry to the show unless can be made. All outside entries without an Authority to Compete certificate will be removed to the exhibition compound.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts of travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events

- When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams
- If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all
- The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink
- Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog
- When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle
- Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated
- Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Right to Refuse Entries: Exhibitors / Competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulation to refuse any entry

If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused

KENNEL CLUB SHOW REGULATION – F REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F(B)

- 1) These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition at a show. When a dog is found to have been prepared for exhibition in contravention of these regulations the exhibitor will be dealt as if a complaint under Kennel Club Rule 42 has been lodged against them and proved to the satisfaction of The General Committee without prejudice to the right of the exhibitor to make representations to the General Committee in mitigation of the penalty to be imposed at the discretion of the general Committee under Rule 42. The dog will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and any award gained thereat. No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the show. Any other substance which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat of a dog at the time of exhibition.
- 2) No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed and nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee.
 - (b) The removal of dewclaws of any kind
 - (c) The shortening of tails of customary docked breeds.
 - (d) Operations to prevent breeding where the animal has progeny registered at the Kennel ClubThe General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at the show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 3) Any individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 4) Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

Exhibitors are reminded that products on Sale by Trade Stands for the preparation and grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements For The Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
